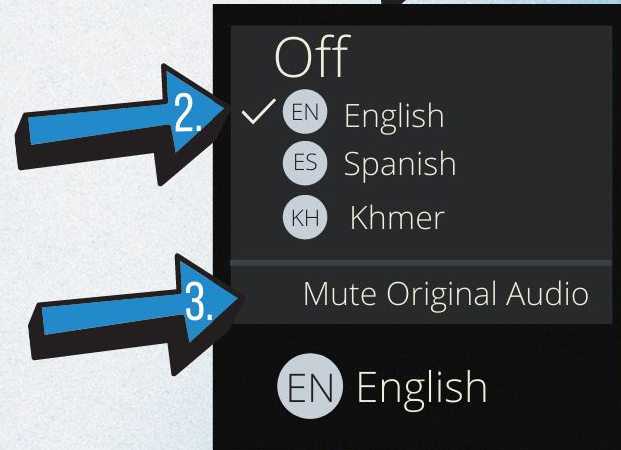

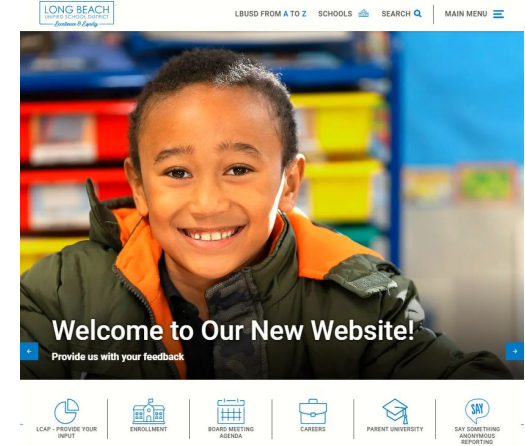

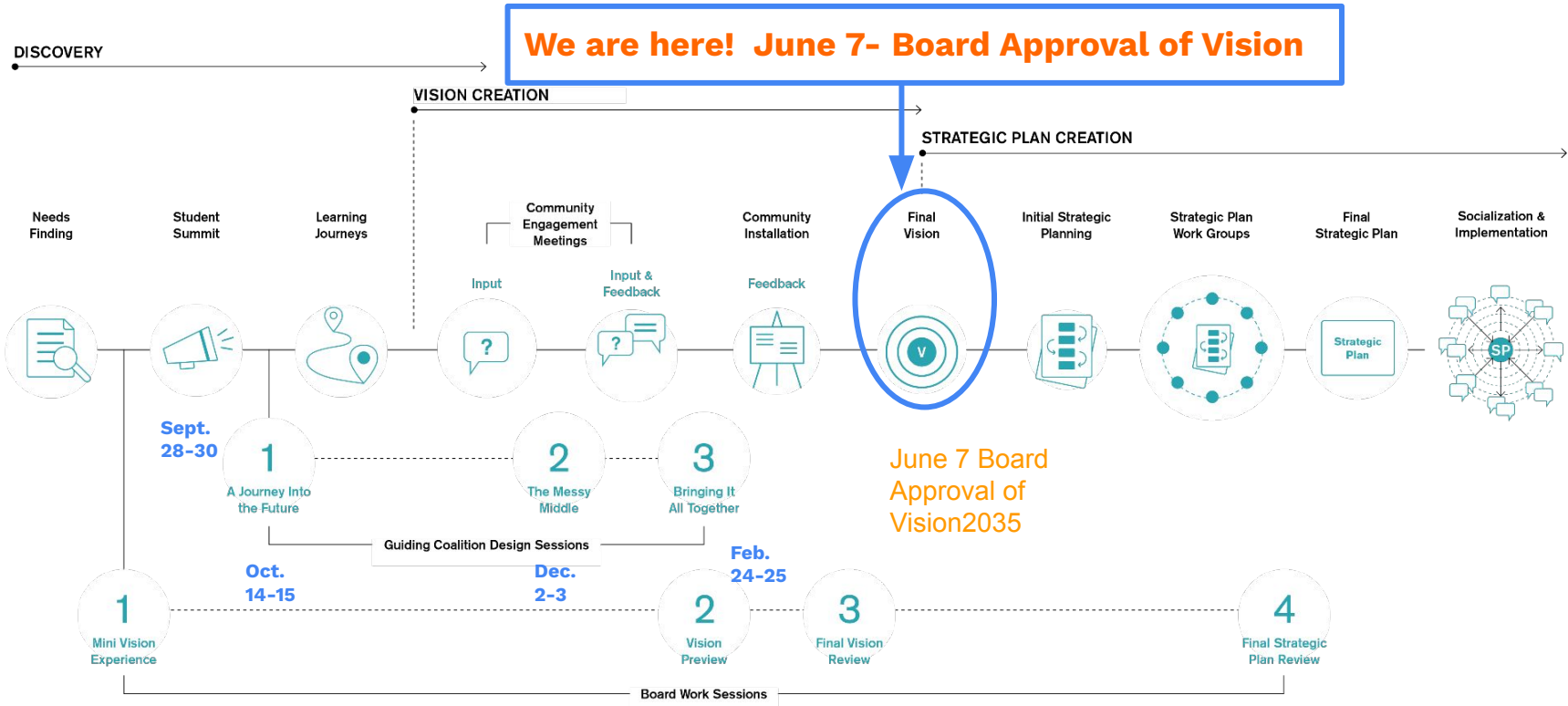
Heat Mitigation Plans

LBUSD Vision and Strategic Planning Process and Timeline





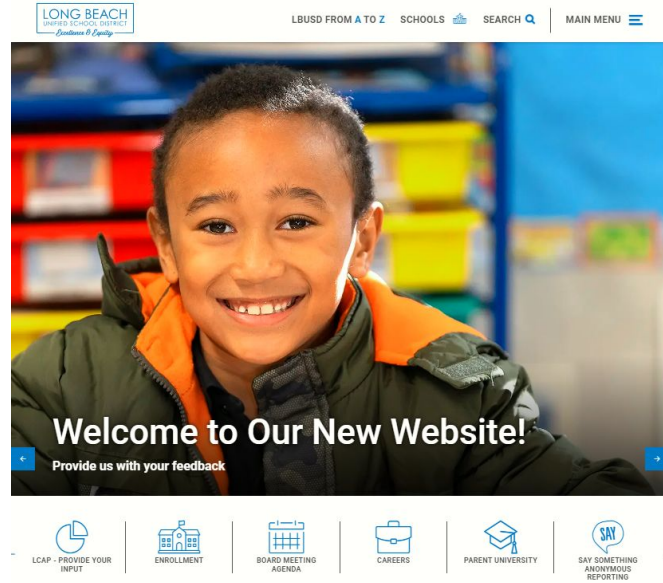
Planning for Heat Mitigation


